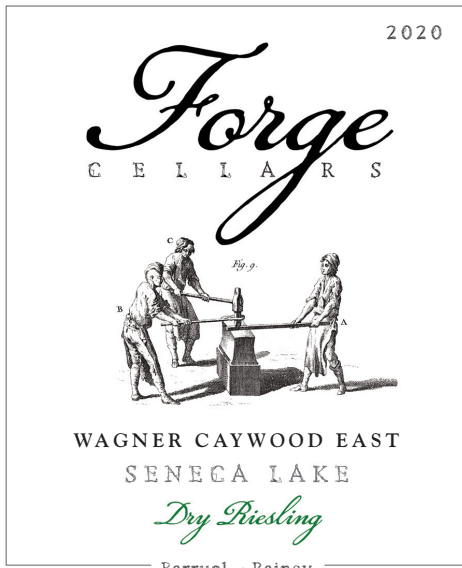

soils, climate). Wagner Caywood East is a lesson in endurance, a power-packed and electric trip along its high elevation, steep, shale-laden terrain.



We often discuss wines being “alive,” referring to their evolution in the cellar, in the bottle, and in the glass. This wine truly feels in motion as it moves across your palate, waking up your senses, feeding you a rush of adrenaline, and finally, offering that same relief that one would find from the coldest sip of water after a steep mountain ascent.
